INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE REGISTRATION OF AN IMPORTED HORSE

1. Owner or designated, recorded Agent should complete the top third on the front of the registration application and sign where it says "owner of the mare at the time of foaling", crossing out the "of mare at the time of foaling" part.
 - a) If the horse being registered is a foal imported in utero, the Breeder and Service Certificates must be submitted on the NAPHA registration application.
 - b) If the horse was registered in Peru after June 1, 2007, owner must provide NAPHA with a copy of the parental verification and a copy of the DNA marker report along with the DNA marker report for the sire and dam, and all fees as stated on the Fee Schedule.
2. Complete the markings section on the back of the application.
3. Return to the NAPHA office with the following:
 - a) Copies of **BOTH** sides of the horse's ANCP CPP (Peruvian) registration papers. (Also AAOBPPH, Canadian or other registration papers if so registered.)
 - b) If the horse was registered in Peru after May of 1982 (see "Fecha de Registro in the lower left corner of the ANCP CPP papers,) the Registry requires documentation that the horse qualifies for a closed stud book. This verification is made via copies of the sire's and dam's ANCP CPP certificates of registration (or grandsire's and granddam's and further back until pedigree shows registration prior to 1982.) If the horse does not qualify, it will be registered provisionally.
 - c) The required color photographs (showing the entire horse - both sides, face and rear in color of the entire horse, clearly showing all markings including face.) Digital photos maybe submitted if printed on quality photographic paper. Color copies are not allowed.
 - d) Put the date of importation on the front of the registration application and label it as such.
 - e) A copy of the USDA - Veterinarian's Report of Inspection for Importation.
 - f) Registration of imported horses is \$125 (members) or \$250 (non-members) during the first year after importation. The fee after one year of importation and before two years is \$250 (members) or \$350 (non-members). Thereafter, the fee is \$500 (members) or \$600 (non-members).

Please note: ALL ungelded males registered or transferred to the NAPHA will be registered with a "T" number indicating that they have not yet been registered for breeding purposes. These horses will be subject to NAPHA rules regarding registration of stallions for breeding (those rules require DNA typing by UC Davis, NAPHA's veterinarian statement completed and signed, stating that the horse has two normal, descended testicles and the fee of \$150 (members) or \$ 200 (non-members) which includes the DNA typing costs.)
