



INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE REGISTRATION OF A HORSE REGISTERED IN CENTRAL AMERICA

1. Owner or designated, recorded Agent should complete the top third on the front of the registration application and sign where it says "owner of the mare at the time of foaling", crossing out the "of mare at the time of foaling" part.
2. Complete the markings section on the back of the application.
3. Return to the NAPHA office with the following:
 - a) Copies of **BOTH** sides of the horse's Central American Papers and official pedigree.
 - b) Copies of the ANCP CPP (Peruvian) registration papers of the horse to be registered and/or its parents, grandparents, etc. to show qualification for a closed ANCP CPP stud book.
 - c) If the horse or its sire/dam, grandsire/granddam were registered in Peru after May of 1982 (see "Fecha de Registro in the lower left corner of the ANCP CPP papers,) NAPHA requires documentation to verify that the horse qualifies for a closed stud book. This verification is made via copies of the sire's and dam's ANCP CPP certificates of registration (or grandsire's and granddam's and further back until pedigree shows registration prior to 1982.) If the horse does not qualify, it will be registered provisionally.
 - d) The required color photographs (both sides, face and rear - side photos must show **CLEARLY** all four legs and markings). If the photos submitted to do not show all four legs from each side and the designated color of the horse, the Registrar will be required to request additional ones. Please clearly label photos with horse's name. We would prefer that the photographs **NOT** be Polaroid type unless they are of excellent quality. Photographs may be digital if printed on quality, photographic paper - clearly and accurately showing the color and markings of the horse. Color copies are not allowed.
 - e) DNA type results (if not done by UC Davis add \$10) or the appropriate fee to DNA type the applicant horse (\$55 member or \$65 non member.)
 - f) Registration of imported horses is \$125 (members) or \$250 (non-members) during the first year after importation. The fee after one year of importation and before two years is \$250 (members) or \$350 (non-members). Thereafter, the fee is \$500 (members) or \$600 (non-members).

Please note: ALL ungelded males registered or transferred to NAPHA will be registered with a "T" number indicating that they have not yet been registered for breeding purposes. These horses will be subject to NAPHA rules regarding registration of stallions for breeding; those rules require DNA typing, a veterinarian's statement that the horse has two normal, descended testicles and a fee, see current NAPHA fee schedule.
